

# Non-US No PayPal, No Clickbank, No Problem

Fundamental to any business is MODE of accepting payment, if you cannot accept/receive payment from your buyer how you are going to pay your bills?! I faced the same problem in online business being a citizen of 3rd world country.

In the beginning when I got started with the IM(Internet Marketing) and Internet Business. I was very anxious to start making my First MONEY online as soon as possible. Yeah Speed Money! :)

Affiliate marketing was the easy way to get started so I started to learn everything I could about affiliate marketing then the day come, when **BIG dream as an Affiliate was shattered**, as I could not sign up with Clickbank. Yes Clickbank will not accept affiliates from my country. Period!

But every affiliate product or guide which I have read so far have taught me to go to Clickbank and start promoting affiliate products. My affiliate marketing was doomed I could not make a buck online using it; these were the feelings I had that time.

I stopped thinking about Affiliate Marketing, LOL for me Affiliate marketing, that time, was to promote the products listed in Clickbank. So you can say I got a **Clickbank Slap?**

I tried to capitalize my skills of web development and joined a small community of freelancers to bid on the small projects, but again...

I faced another problem that clients will not assign me projects as I did not accept PayPal as a payment source (I was using Western Union and did not know much about PayPal that time).

What is PayPal?! “Oh it is free to join, very easy to use and it is great service”, they told me. It was great to know that there was such a great service online. But you know the second part, when I tried to get PayPal, another discouraging moment in my life came in, as I could not sign up, YES they also do not accept signup from my country. Another slap, can be named as **PayPal Slap?**

So problems like this made me very disappointed that time when I was just starting out and my ambition of making MONEY online started to slow down. I tried some loop holes, like getting US bank account and linking that to PayPal and Clickbank, and I was busted by PayPal. They let me receive money in there but then they limited my account and asked me to submit all those documents which I could never produce.

So this was happening, and on one good day, a friend of mine from Singapore said, Mohsin do not focus too much on problem, instead look for the Opportunities. Did I follow his advice from that day? Nope, like a dumb kid I just did not started to follow that advice. But then realizations come in...

With the passage of time, I started to focus on Opportunities than Problems as my friend advised me. Yes there were many alternatives I never thought of, or I did not know about them that time.

Today I have found solid alternatives to these problems (**Payment Processing & Affiliate Marketing**) and Thank God! I am earning a healthy consistent living online, which is enough to support my studies, my personal lifestyle and my family. Now I want to pay it back, I am going to share some tips for Warriors (Yeah You my Warrior Friend in IM :) who may face the same situation I had to face when I first get started online.

## **A. Payment Processing – Non-Paypal**

A. Well if no PayPal, go for 2Checkout, yeah as simple as abc 😊 ,with 2Checkout you can even accept PayPal payments (we were lucky they added this feature in 2007).

There is two big disadvantages you may face with 2Co but again we have solution for that right in this thread

1. You can not simply give your email and accept any payment. You have to create a Product for every payment in 2Co panel and then give that link to accept payments.

But most of the time people are so much used to PayPal that they will not use another system, they will ask you give them PayPal email of yours so they can send you any amount they wanted to send you.

It will be very time consuming and difficult for you to accept varying amounts of money from various clients, I mean varying amounts charged to clients depending on the situation and work done.

I have found solution for this, we can use 2Co just link PayPal to accept any amount of payment without creating millions of products in 2Co a/c with various price combinations.

Whenever someone want to send you any amount or cold beer and ask your paypal email! Send them to the payment page at your Website with the form for payment like this [WarMarks.com/payment](http://WarMarks.com/payment)

This is a form for 2Co payments with variable price, and it works like a charm. I use it almost every day to accept payments from my website development and consultancy clients.

Not a single client of mine have ever complained that they did not like the above mentioned payment form, whenever they aske me for my Paypal email for any amount or extra bonus for my work, I simply send them to this form and tell them that they can pay from their PayPal account using this form ;-)

(You can view the source code of this form and use as template for your own account, do not forget to replace my account particulars with yours) --- Or submit support ticket at [WarMarks.com/support](http://WarMarks.com/support) and let one of my team members help you with this for a small fee or no cost if you cannot pay at this stage 😊 . I totally understand this stage, as I have been there!

2. The second big disadvantage of 2Checkout is that they have \$49 sign up fee whereas PayPal is free to sign up. Some time it is difficult for new comers to spend money when they have not earned any money online, it is even more difficult from a 3<sup>rd</sup> world country when your credit card does not work online.

In this case you may go for Plimus.com, This is free to join payment solution, they accept PayPal, and system is very flexible to set up on your website.

But their fees are higher as compared to PayPal and 2Co. But as I did, go for 2Co, but if at start you could not, go for Plimus\*, earn some bucks and then move to 2Co when you have money for sign up. As 2Checkout is really a payment solution you want to use for your long term established business.

*\* Plimus has another drawback a customer of Plimus shared that, when someone try to purchase from you when you are using Plimus, they will not accept any gmail,msn or yahoo free emails from your customers. Sometime this hurts your purchases. Now you know it.*

## B. Affiliate Marketing – Non-Clickbank:

You cannot sign up with Clickbank, your affiliate marketing is doomed, Right?

**WRONG!** Believe me, ok I explain, keep reading...

This is exactly what I used to think in those hard days. But I honestly tell you buddy, this is not true, yes Clickbank is an easy way to go but it is not the end of the world!

You can still make big bucks as an affiliate prompting products on the internet even if you cannot sign up with Clickbank. You just need to look somewhere else

and you will see many alternatives, and best thing is most of those resources are not highly-competitive, highly saturated networks as is the case with Clickbank.

Here are few affiliate networks which accept affiliates almost from every country around the globe, hope your country is also in there, and

I have used most of them, they comes highly recommended, they are reputed and reliable guys. They actually pay to their affiliates, yes to YOU my dear very soon, look for the registered post at your name with the check (aka Cheuqe)! 😊

4. Google Adsense (Yes you are their affiliate :)
5. Amazon Associate program

Also many product owners have individual affiliate programs for their products hosted and managed by them, they may accept your country so consider to sign up with them also.

For example for hosting market, I have promoted Hostgator as an affiliate, it is affiliate program independently hosted by them and they pay through check. And I confidentially tell you that they also actually pay at time.

You should check site and affiliate programs for individual products in your Niche and great chance is that you will find some affiliate programs where you would be allowed to sign up.

No you know if you cannot sign up with Clickbank, so what? Should you stop affiliate marketing, not at all, never be discouraged by little hurdles in your path to success, I tell you these little hurdles are here to test you, and to make you stronger, at the end of the day you will be glad that you did not stopped, you did not quit!

So use above networks as an alternative to Clickbank for your affiliate marketing and start making Moolah Online.

Do not let these SMALL problems discourage you and do not let them stop you to prove yourself and your skills online. Please for us, prove to the world, that being the citizen outside the top country is not a disadvantage. You are not to going buy this excuse.

Again I am here to share my experiences and lessons I learned in Internet Marketing doing business from a 3rd world country.
